



Cooperation Agreement

This cooperation agreement is entered into by and between the following parties as of 1/1/2026.

1. Association of Paragliding Pilots and Instructors ("APPI")
2. Paramotor and Paragliding Association of Ghana ("PPAG")

Whereas, APPI is an independent organization offering pilots and instructors a unified worldwide education system.

Whereas, the PPAG is the association representing paragliding in Ghana.

The parties hereby agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

Both parties agree to keep, perform and fulfill the promise and conditions set out in this agreement:

Scope of Cooperation

- The PPAG chooses APPI system as official education system in Ghana
- The PPAG uses APPI license as official paragliding and powered paragliding license for Ghana. APPI license becomes APPI-PPAG license for the residents of Ghana.
- The PPAG officially recognizes APPI pilot, tandem, instructor and master certifications, in free flight, Powered paragliding, whether they have been issued in Ghana or abroad.
- The PPAG understands that a resident of Ghana might learn paragliding in any APPI school worldwide and earn APPI rating. This member will be eligible to get the APPI-PPAG license

-APPI provides access to its educational resources and online exam system in order to have pilots train and take theoretical exams.

-Theoretical and practical exams will be conducted by APPI certified instructors. Certifications will be issued only upon reaching APPI published standards.

-APPI invites advanced pilotes from Ghana to train with APPI in order to build a team of APPI local instructors. The goal is to have APPI system work autonomously in Ghana driven by local Instructors.

-APPI-PPAG license for residents of Ghana will carry together the PPAG and the APPI logo corresponding to the member's rating.

-Only members that are current of their membership can print the official APPI-PPAG license.

-Members that are NOT current of their membership can print their "APPI rating certificate" showing the ratings they own.

-The PPAG has a specific access to the APPI database (the PPAG's profile) where they can manage APPI members residents of Ghana.

-If there is any disciplinary issue with an APPI member resident of Ghana, the APPI disciplinary committee will inform the PPAG.

-If there is any disciplinary issue with an APPI member flying in Ghana, the PPAG will inform APPI disciplinary committee which will investigate and take the appropriate actions.

AMENDMENT

This Agreement may not be amended, altered or modified except by a subsequent written document signed by all Parties.

TERMINATION

This Agreement shall become effective upon signing by the Parties, for 4 years and renewable on mutually agreed terms, unless terminated by APPI and the PPAG bilaterally.

It might be revised at anniversary date if required bilaterally.
